University calls for applications for the UNICORE 6.0 program are currently open. Students can submit their applications - along with the required documents - between 1st March and 15th April 2024 at 12:00 p.m. (noon, UTC+2), exclusively through the UNICORE website: <https://universitycorridors.unhcr.it/>.

It is possible to apply to a maximum of two universities. Should an eligible application not be selected by one of the two universities chosen, if some scholarships have yet to be awarded, it will be shared with other universities participating in UNICORE 6.0.

All applications that are not properly filled out or complete with all the required documentation will not be accepted. It is not possible to submit applications in any other way than the one described above.

Some universities might require you to also submit the application through their admission platforms. If this is the case, you will be notified by the university upon submission of the present application form.
