## Selection Notice

### Intensive Summer Programme for Economics Students

#### **"Corporate valuation and financial simulations in global financial markets"**

**Sibiu (Romania), 25 June -1 July 2024**

### 1 - Object

A selection is hereby announced for 5 places to participate in the Intensive Summer Programme for Economics Students "Corporate valuation and financial simulations in global financial markets" to be held in Sibiu (Romania) from 25 June to 1 July 2024.

### 2 - Requirements

Knowledge of English at B1 level, at least, is required. In the absence of language certifications, language preparation can be assessed through an interview at the selection venue. Those enrolled in the bachelor's or master's degree courses held in English are considered suitable from the point of view of language preparation.

### 3 - Eligible candidates

Students from the University of Siena who are regularly enrolled in the bachelor's degree Courses in the Department of Business and law may participate in the selection.

**The winners must be regularly enrolled, during their period abroad, at the University of Siena.**

### 4 - Costs and financial contributions

Participants will receive a contribution of 797 euros, useful to help them pay for travel, food, and accommodation expenses.

### 5 - Selection of candidates

The selection of students will be entrusted to a committee composed of at least three (3) professors appointed by Prof. Maurizio Pompella, academic representative of the University of Siena for the summer program teaching activity.

Students will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- motivational letter.
- level of knowledge of English.
- university career and curriculum vitae.

Based on the criteria indicated, a ranking of the candidates will be drawn up. A score (of maximum 100 points) will be awarded for each of the following:

MOTIVATION (40%)	0 to 40 points
KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH (30%)	0 to 30 points
UNIVERSITY CAREER AND CV	0 to 30 points

Places will be allocated up to the number of places available according to the ranking.

If more places become available than those indicated in this notice, the additional places will be assigned based in the order of the drawn-up ranking.

Priority is given to candidates who have never taken part in mobility programs. In the presence of equal conditions, the age criterion (priority for older candidates) will be applied.

The winner will be required to comply with the terms within which to communicate acceptance or waiver of the opportunity offered. If this term is not respected, the winner will lose all rights and the next one in the ranking will be appointed.

Upon acceptance, the name of the winner will be communicated to the coordinating institution, who will contact the student directly to inform him/her of the completion of the required procedures.

## 6. Applications

The applications, drawn up on the form available on the website, the attachments, and the copy of an identity document, must be sent exclusively by e-mail in a single pdf file to the address [amministrazione.disag@unisi.it](mailto:amministrazione.disag@unisi.it) from the candidate's institutional address of the domain unisi.it (the documents received from other domains will not be taken into consideration).

Upon application to participate in this selection, the candidate must attach:

- Student application form.
- Self-certification of enrolment at the University of Siena and the exams taken.
- Self-certification of the achievement of the bachelor's degree, the final mark reported, and all the exams taken with the corresponding marks, for those who have already obtained the bachelor's degree.
- Eventual certificate of knowledge of English at least at B1 level (in the event the student is not in possession of academic linguistic qualifications of level B1 or is not enrolled in courses held in English),
- Motivation letter in English.
- Curriculum Vitae

The application must be completed in full and duly signed. Incomplete applications or applications missing the required attached documentation will not be accepted.

In any case, applications must be received no later than 24:00 on April 5, 2024.
